## Other events taking Place

**The Kennel Club Good Citizen Dog Testing Scheme – Bronze level.** Charge for this event £9 to include a Rosette and Certificate on successful completion. (All dogs must wear a collar and tag).

**Agility** - Is a comparatively new form of dog competition, where the animal's fitness and the handler's ability to train and direct the dog over and through certain obstacles are tested.

**Scurry** - Your dog's time is measured over a course of 5 straw bales and the shortest time wins a prize.

Charity Dog Show Rules	
1	All owners are responsible for their own dog
2	<b>All dogs entered must be 6 months old or over</b>
3	Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times (Except when instructed otherwise by the judges)
4	Any Dog being aggressive to other dogs or the Judge and Stewards will be asked to leave the ring
5	Children under the age of 5 years old are not permitted in the ring
6	Owners are responsible for clearing up after their dogs.
7	This is a Charity Event - So no refunds will be given.
8	The Judge's decision is final.
9	No CC, Reserve CC or Junior Warrant winners may enter the Pedigree Classes
