Other events taking Place

The Kennel Club Good Citizen Dog Testing Scheme – Bronze level.

Charge for this event £6 to include Certificate on successful completion, or with a Rosette £9. (All dogs must wear a collar and tag).

Obedience Test. This comprises Heelwork, Heel Free and Stay/ Leave/ Recall - off lead.

To compete a handler or dog must not have won a First place in any licensed Kennel Club Pre-Beginners or Beginners classes nor gained a third place or above in any other Kennel Club Obedience class, nor gained a qualifying score in FCI obedience level 1

Full instructions will be provided on the day

Agility

We are thankful to Edipaws Dog Walking and Pet Care Services for running this event in which an animal's fitness and the handler's ability to train and direct the dog over and through certain obstacles are tested. There will be a demonstration, have a go as well as a competition for you to enter.

Scurry

Your dog's time is measured over a course of 5 straw bales and the shortest time wins a prize.

Rules and Regulations

- 1 All owners are responsible for their own dog
- 2 **All dogs entered must be 6 months old or over**
- 3 Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times (Except when instructed otherwise by the judges)
- 4 Any Dog being aggressive to other dogs or the Judge and Stewards will be asked to leave the ring
- 5 Children under the age of 5 years old are not permitted in the ring
- 6 Owners are responsible for clearing up after their dogs.
- 7 This is a Charity Event - So no refunds will be given.
- 8 The Judge's decision is final.
- 9 No CC, Reserve CC or Junior Warrant winners may enter the Pedigree Classes
